

n March 2022, Botswana's total imports were valued at P 9, 872, 555, 567.2. In this amount, food imports contributed P 1, 173, 829, 205 translating to 11.9 percent. Cereals accounted for 26.8 percent of food imports, followed by Beverages, Spirits & Vinegar and Animal or vegetable fats and oils with 13.8 percent and 8.0 percent respectively.

Among cereals, the most imported in March 2022 was grain sorghum other than seed and maize

(corn) other than seed with contributions of 51.4 percent and 21.0 percent respectively.


With respect to Beverages, Spirits & Vinegar, the most imported types were Non-alcoholic beverages; at 25.4 percent. Beer; made from malt and Waters; including mineral and aerated, containing sugar or other sweetening matter or flavoured, followed with contributions of 22.0 percent and 20.6 percent respectively.
