BOTSWANA FOOD IMPORTS September 2023

Botswana's total imports were valued at P7,724.7 million in September 2023. In this amount, food imports contributed 16.8 percent (P1, 299.4 million) of total imports. Beverages, Spirits & Vinegar contributed highest imported food items at 34.2 percent. Cereals and Miscellaneous edible preparations followed with 12.4 percent and 7.6 percent respectively.


Within the Beverages, Spirits and Vinegar chapter, the most imported commodities were Mineral waters & aerated waters containing added sugar or other sweetening matter or flavoured and Beer from malt, accounting for 60.0 percent and 15.5 percent respectively. Other fermented beverages (for example, cider, perry, mead, sake) and mixtures of fermented beverages & non-alcoholic beverages contributed 10.4 percent.

Regarding Cereals chapter, Other wheat & muslin and Other Maize (Corn) contributed 45.5 percent and 33.0 percent in that order. Semi-milled or wholly milled rice whether or not polished or glazed contributed 13.9 percent to the chapter.
