

# Annual Agricultural Survey Report 2013



The survey is part of a series of household surveys carried out by Statistics Botswana through the Agricultural Statistics Unit (ASU) and in collaboration with the Department of Agricultural Research, Statistics and Policy Development (DARSPD) of the Ministry of Agriculture. The agricultural surveys provide time series data on key production indicators in the livestock and crop sub-sectors for evidence-based policy development, decision-making as well as to monitor and evaluate Government development programmes and projects. Among others, the information covers livestock production indicators such as birth, off-take and death rates. Under the crop sector, it covers area planted and harvested as well as production and yield of various crops.


# Botswana Aids Impact Survey IV (BAIS IV) 2013

BAIS IV was conducted between January and April 2013. This Summary Report provides the key results of BAIS IV, 2013. Key indicators covered in the report are current HIV incidence and prevalence estimates among the population aged six weeks to 64 years and indicative trends in preventive behaviour among the population aged 10 to 64 years in Botswana.

The crime classification used in the analysis of the data was adopted from the Irish Crime classification and adapted for the Botswana context. Data was sourced electronically from the Case Information Management System (CIMS), located at the Gaborone High Court.




The index is used as a proxy to the cost of living changes and it therefore enables the Government to update taxes, public service remuneration, etc.

This Stats Brief provides information on Botswana Maternal Mortality Ratio and causes of maternal deaths for the period 2009 – 2013. Maternal Mortality Ratio is defined as the number of deaths per 100,000 live births.

As part of a collaborative effort between Statistics Botswana and the Ministry of Health (Department of PublicHealth- Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH) to improve the availability and quality of maternal mortality information, the two organizations, ensure that data on live births and maternal deaths are provided.


# Literacy Survey 2013-STATS BRIEF
