## 2016 FOURTH QUARTER AND 2016 PROVISIONAL ANNUAL GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT (GDP) ESTIMATES

Statistics Botswana has published the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of <u>Gross Domestic Product</u> <u>(GDP)</u> and the 2016 annual estimates. The GDP is estimated to have grown by 4.3 percent in 2016 compared to a decline of 1.7 percent recorded in 2015, mainly due to the increase in Trade, Hotels and Restaurants Sector particularly the wholesale sub-sector, which includes diamond aggregation processes.

The 2016 positive performance was due to the improvement in the global diamond market compared to the 2015 unstable commodity prices.

The 2016 estimates are provisional and subject to change because they are based on limited data and hence cannot be precise and absolute. The figures will be revised after receiving finalized or audited data from companies.

Statistics Botswana is considering reviewing the periodicity of GDP estimates due to the limited source of data in the estimates process.
