# PREFACE

The 2022 Quarter 3, Stats Brief gives a summary of international visitors entering the country during this quarter. The annual report will give detailed information on arrivals and departures as well as tourist arrivals for the entire year. During this quarter, some border posts started operating in August due to travel restrictions imposed to address the COVID-19 pandemic.

The statistics contained therein include the arrival of non-citizens by country of residence and other key characteristics. These statistics are compiled from electronic and manual embarkation records completed at gazetted points of entry into the country and cover all ports of entry as well as airports that were in operation.

The country received a total of 254,049 international visitors (tourists) during the third quarter of 2022. These represented 63.4 percent of total non-citizen arrivals (400,452) the bulk of whom emanated from the SADC sub-region. South Africa contributed 84,890, representing 33.4 percent of overall tourists.

For purpose of visit, those who came for Holiday/Leisure represented the highest proportion of tourists, at 32.4 percent (82,236) followed by the In-Transit at 23.5 percent (59,820), while those who came for Business and for Visiting Friends & Relatives (VFR) accounted for 19.3 percent each at (49,143) and (49,064) tourists respectively.

## 1.0 Total Arrivals

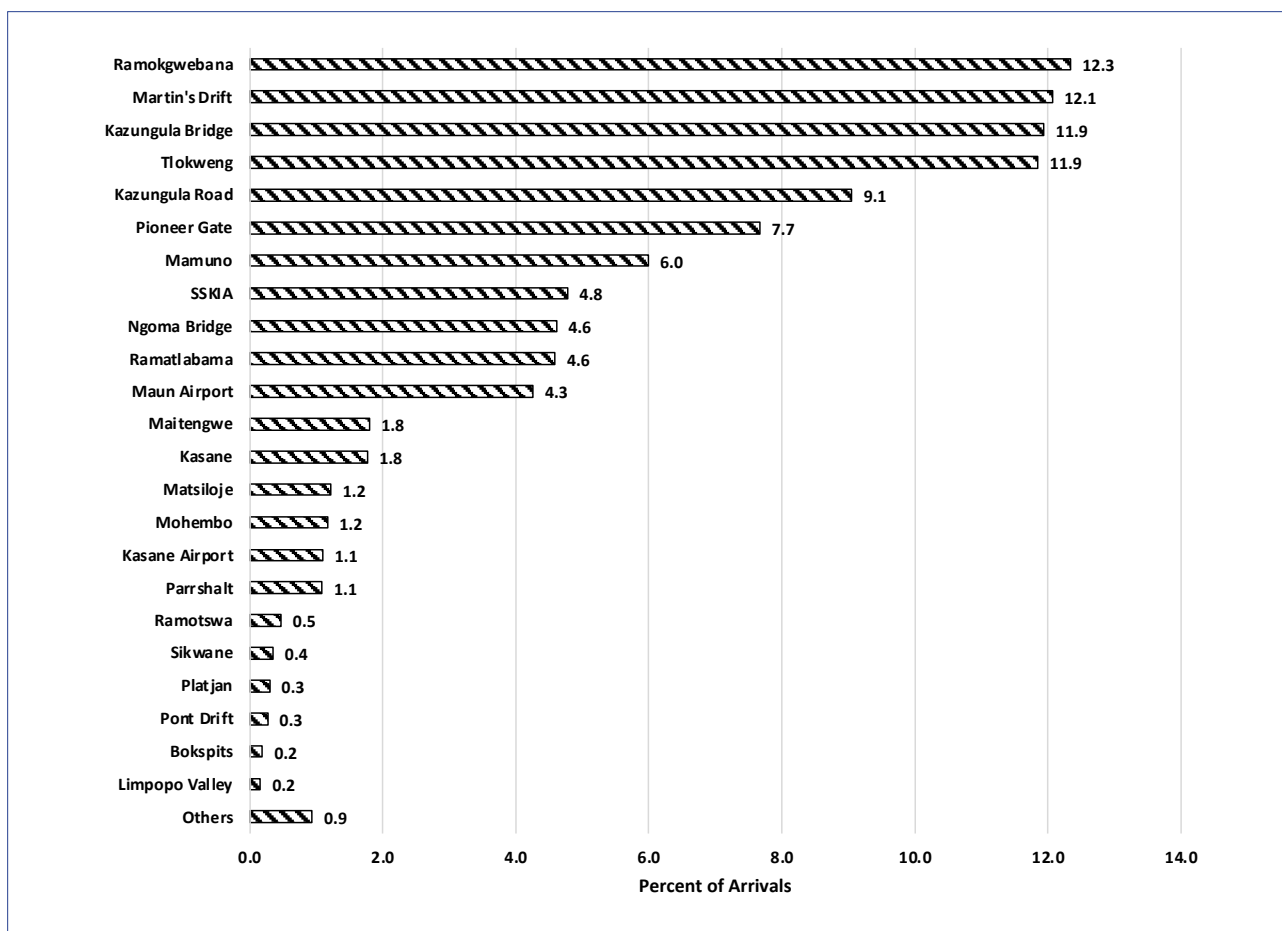
This section deals with all international arrivals, including tourists and returning residents, but excludes Botswana citizens, for Quarter 3, 2022. **Appendix 2** and **13** show that the country received 400,452 arrivals, with August recording a slightly higher percentage of arrivals at 34.9 percent (139,725), while September and July recorded 33.4 percent (133,680) and 31.7 percent (127,047) respectively.

**Appendix 4** presents total international arrivals by purpose of entry. It shows that most arrivals were those In-Transit at 29.9 percent (119,640), followed by those who came for Holiday/Leisure at 20.5 percent (82,236). Those who came for Business accounted for 12.3 percent (49,143) and those who came to visit friends and relatives represented 12.3 percent (49,064) of total arrivals.

## 1.1 Port of Entry

**Figure 1** and **Appendix 2** show the number of arrivals per border post. Most arrivals came by road using Ramokgwebana Border Post at 12.3 percent (49,431), followed by Martin's Drift Border Post at 12.1 percent (48,330). The busiest airport was Sir Seretse Khama International Airport, having received 4.8 percent (19,141) arrivals.

Others – All points of entry each accounting for 0.1 percent or less

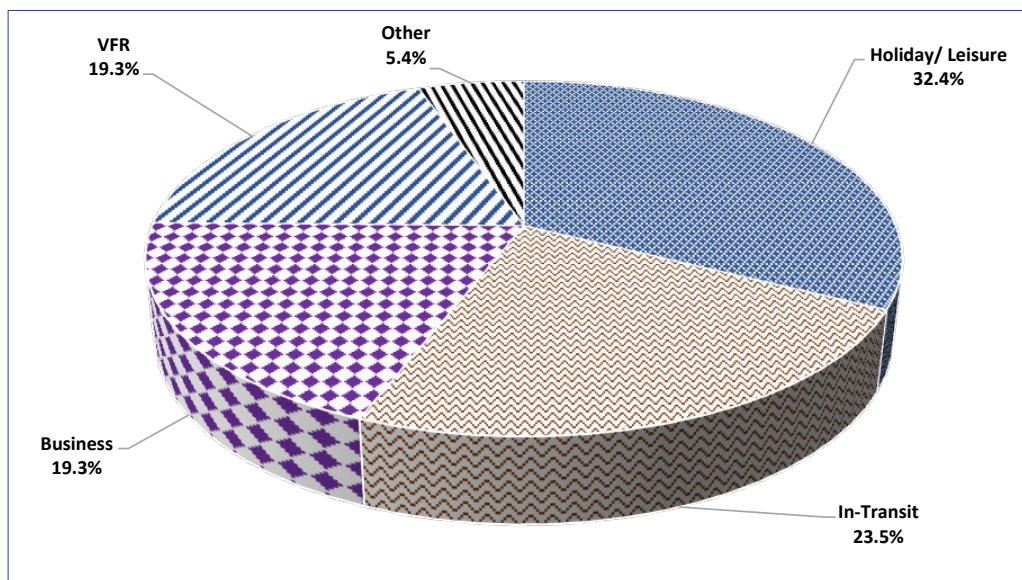
## 2.0 Visitor Arrivals

In the third quarter of 2022, the country recorded a total of 400,452 non-citizen arrivals and 63.4 percent (254,049) of these were international visitors (tourists). The majority of the visitors originated from the SADC Region. **Appendix 11** shows that most tourists came from South Africa, Zimbabwe and Zambia. These three countries together accounted for 61.7 percent (156,847) of all tourists, at 33.4 percent (84,890), 17.8 percent (45,145) and 10.6 percent (26,812) respectively.

## 2.1 Purpose of Visit

**Figure 2** and **Appendix 3** shows the distribution of tourists by purpose of visit. Most of the tourists came for holiday/leisure at 32.4 percent (82,236). These were followed by those who were in-transit at 23.5 percent (59,820), business (49,143) and VFR (49,064) at 19.3 percent each. The least number was for those who came for 'Other' purposes, making up 5.4 percent (13,786) of total tourists.

### 2.1.1 Sex Distribution

The distribution in **Table 1** and **Figure 3** shows that more males visited Botswana compared to females during the quarter under review. Male tourists contributed 65.9 percent (167,386) of all tourist visitors compared to 34.1 percent (86,663) of female tourists. This disparity is also observed in the purpose of visit by sex. The In-Transit and Business accounted for 83.3 percent (49,819) males to 16.7 percent (10,001) females and 81.5 percent (40,062) males to 18.5 percent (9,081) females respectively.



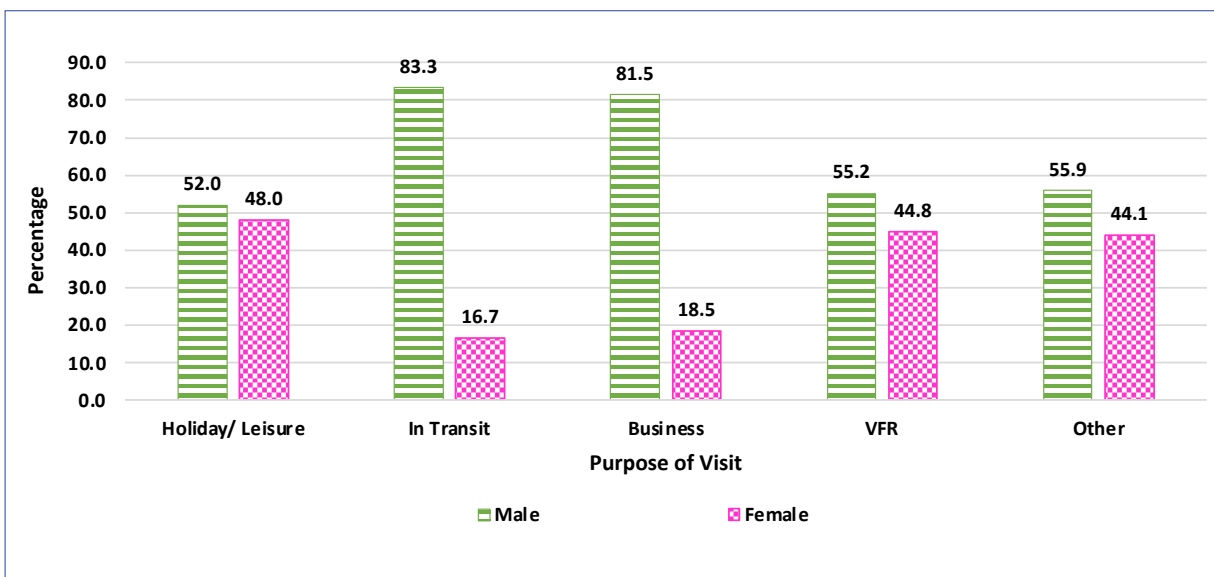

## 2.1.2 Length of Stay

**Table 2** and **Table 3** present the length of stay of tourists during this quarter. The majority of tourists spent four to seven (4–7) days at 31.0 percent (78,767), followed by those who spent one to three (1–3) days, accounting for 24.8 percent (63,085).

Holiday/Leisure tourists mostly stayed for more than 21 days at 23.5 percent (19,323). Those who were In Transit mostly stayed 4-7 days at 44.6 percent (26,704).

Those who visited for purposes of Business and Visiting Friends and Relatives mainly spent 4-7 days at 43.7 percent (21,497) and 32.3 percent (15,835) respectively as can be observed in **Table 2**.

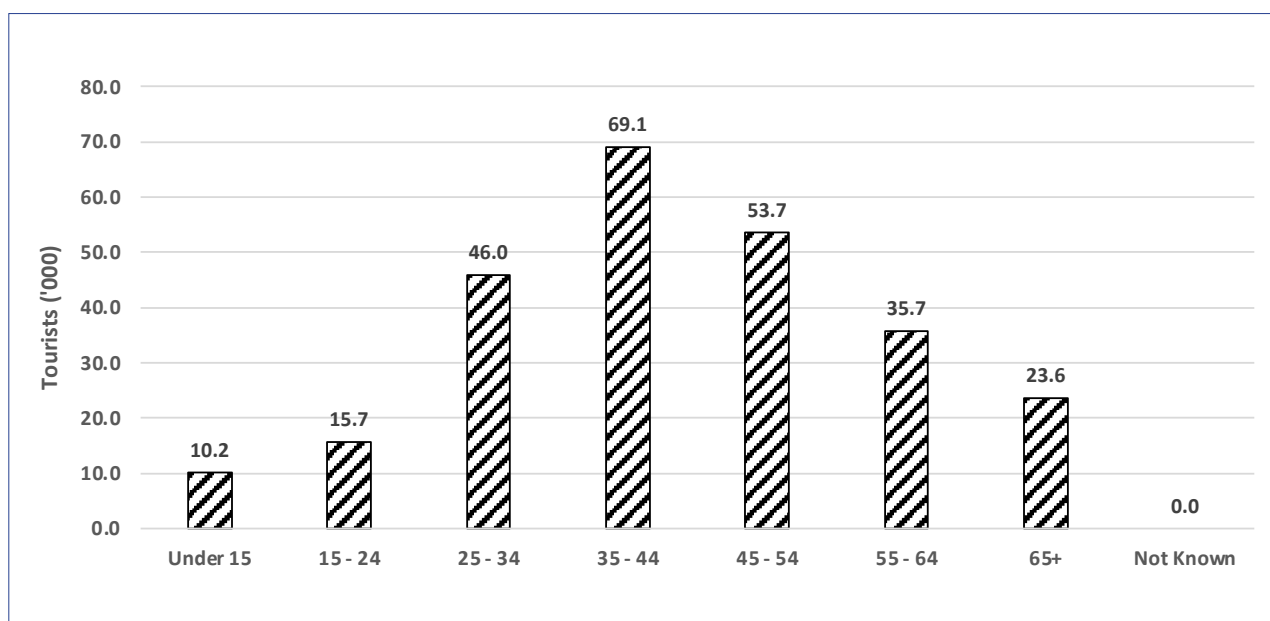

### 2.1.3 Age group

**Figure 4** and **Appendix 7**, present the distribution of tourists by age group. During this quarter, the majority of tourists were in the middle ages of 35-44 years, representing 27.2 percent (69,113) of total tourist arrivals (254,049).

The age group 45-54 accounted for 21.1 percent (53,656) of total tourists, followed by those aged 25-34 years with 18.1 percent (46,025).

## 2.2 Key Overseas Countries

The United States of America was the major source of tourists from overseas countries. The country supplied 33.6 percent (18,986) of all top ten overseas tourists, followed by Germany and the United Kingdom at 18.7 percent (10,584) and 14.8 percent (8,363) in that order. Australia occupied the last spot with 3.0 percent (1,720), see [Table 4](#).

As can be observed in [Table 4](#), the top ten overseas countries had Holiday/Leisure as the main purpose of visit. Overall, the category represented 87.4 percent (49,418) of the 56,523 tourists from the Top Ten Overseas countries. In Transit is the second most popular purpose of entry at 5.5 percent (3,107). [Appendix 9](#) shows a detailed analysis of tourists by country and continent of residence.

## 2.3 Key African Countries

**Table 5**, based on **Appendix 9** shows tourists by country of residence and purpose of visit from key African countries. They accounted for 72.1 percent (183,162) of the total tourists. South Africa comes first with 46.3 percent (84,890). Zimbabwe had the second largest number of tourists amongst the top ten African countries, at 24.6 percent (45,145), followed by Zambia with 14.6 percent (26,812).

Visitors from Zimbabwe whose purpose of visit is described as shopping, religious activities, medical reasons, etc. constitute 54.6 percent (7,316) of all visitors from the top 10 African countries arriving in Botswana under that category of visit.

## 2.4 Country and Region of Residence

**Table 6** shows that most of the source countries are from the African continent. The continent provided 73.1 percent (185,715) of tourists. The SADC Sub Region accounted for the majority with 72.0 (182,948), while 1.1 percent (2,767) came from the Rest of Africa. Europe accounted for 15.8 percent (40,221) of total tourists. The least number of tourists were from the Middle East at 0.4 percent (941).

## 3.0 Technical Notes

This section presents data sources, methodology and definitions of terms used in the production of tourism statistics. This is meant to enable the users to interpret the statistics carried in this statistics brief with an understanding of how the data is sourced, how processing and compilation of the report is done and what the various terms used in the report mean.

### 3.1 Data Source and Methodology

The data used in the production of this report is sourced from administrative records of the Department of Immigration and Citizenship.

International tourist data used in this publication was collected using arrival forms that were completed by non-citizens at gazetted ports of entry (Land Borders and Airports). Each form asks questions on the personal characteristics of the traveller which include among others, sex, age, country of nationality, country of residence and purpose of entry. By default, data is also collected on the month of travel, mode of transport and point of entry.

The results and analysis presented in the report follow the guidelines, definitions and classifications recommended by the UN Tourism and the United Nations Statistical Commission (UNSC). This publication is produced in line with internationally accepted statistical standards and guidelines.

### 3.2 Glossary

**Traveller**- An individual who moves between different geographic locations (in this case country) for any purpose and any duration.

**Overseas** – All countries and territories outside the continent of Africa

**Visitor** - Refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than twelve consecutive months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from the place visited.

**Tourist (Overnight)** – An international visitor who stays at least one night in a collective or private accommodation in the country visited.

**Same-day visitor**– An international visitor who does not spend the night in either a collective or private accommodation in the country visited.

**Excursionist** – A same-day visitor whose trip does not include an overnight stay (usually for leisure).

**Resident** – Refers to a non-citizen residing in Botswana on a permanent or temporary basis.

**Country of Nationality:** A country where citizenship is held.

**Non-resident** – Refers to a foreigner (excluding residents) entering or departing the country.
