WORK PERMITS HOLDERS STATS BRIEF Third Quarter 2015 NO: 2016/08



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1.0 Introduction

This stats brief presents a summary of the characteristics of expatriates who held valid work permits as at end of September 2015.

The Department of Labour and Social Security issue work-permits and copies of approved work-permit applications are forwarded to Statistics Botswana to be analyzed. Although all work permit forms received by Statistics Botswana for a specific quarter are processed and entered into the data base, those valid on the reference dates may still arrive after the publication of the stats brief.

Information on work permit holders gives an indication of whether localization is being achieved or not. It is also of interest to know whether the number of work permit holders is decreasing or not over time. Presentation of work permit holders by occupation and industry gives an indication of jobs currently held by non-citizens or the need for expatriate recruitment. This provides useful information for researchers, planners and policy makers in the country.


Figure 2 presents Employee and Self-Employed work permit holders distribution by Industry. Overall, Agriculture had the largest work permit holders at 25.0 percent, followed by Construction with 17.4 percent. Wholesale and Trade was third with 11.4 percent work permit holders.

Three graphical presentations are given; Figure 1 presents work permit holders by Nationality, with Figures 2 & 3 depicting work permit holders by industry and occupation respectively. More detailed information is presented in tables.


2.0 TOTAL WORK PERMIT HOLDERS

The total number of work permit holders that were valid as of end of September 2015 was 5,999. Of these 4,523 (75.4 percent) were employees while 1,476 (24.6 percent) were self – employed. Overall, male work permit holders at 76.8 percent were higher than their female counterparts (23.2 %). (See Table 1.1a)

Employee work permit holders consist of those holding new work permits and those whose work permits have been renewed. Table 1.4a shows that 3,875 permit holders were new employee work permits, while 648 held renewed ones. Males dominate females for both new and renewed work permit holders. In the new work permit holders category, males accounted for 67.0 percent of total employee work permit holders compared to 18.7 percent for females, while for the renewed, male employee work permit holders accounted for 11.5 percent of the total employee work permit holders compared with 2.9 percent for females.

Table 1.5 shows quarterly work permit holders by industry and sex, from the fourth quarter of 2014 to the third quarter of 2015. Total work permits were declining over the four quarters. Between March 2015 and September 2015, total work permits holders declined by 261 persons, from 6,260 in March 2015 to 5,999 in September 2015, a decrease of 4.2 percent.

Figure 1 and Table 1.1b depicts work permit holders by country of origin. The majority of work permit holders were from Zimbabwe at 2,447 persons (40.8 percent), followed by South Africa at 998 persons (16.6 percent) and China with 619 persons (10.3 percent).




3.0 WORK PERMIT HOLDRES BY AGE GROUP

The age distribution shows that a large number of work permit holders are in the 35 - 39 years age group, at 18.6 percent of total work permit holders, followed by the 30-34 and 40-44 years age groups at 17.9 and 17.5 percent respectively. For the self-employed category, age group 40 – 44 has the largest share with 247 permit holders (16.7 percent) followed by the 45 – 49 age group with 225 permit holders (15.3 percent). For employee work permit holders, the 35 – 39 age group had 902 permit holders (19.9 percent) followed by age group 30 – 34 with 874 work permit holders (19.3 percent), See Table 1.2a & 1.2 b.

4.0 WORK PERMIT HOLDERS BY INDUSTRY

For the employee work permit holders, Agriculture was still the dominant industry at 30.9 percent, followed by Construction with 20.1 percent. However, for the self-employed work permit holders' category, Wholesale & Retail Trade dominated other industries, recording 36.7 percent of work permit holders, followed by Real Estate and Manufacturing with 16.7 and 10.3 percent respectively.



5.0 WORK PERMIT HOLDERS BY OCCUPATION

Figure 3, Tables 1.4a and 1.4b show employee work permit holders (new or renewed), and their occupation. The largest proportion are found in the elementary occupations with 1,322 persons (29.2 percent), followed by the Professionals with 893 persons (19.7 percent) and Managers/ Administrators with 881 persons (19.5 percent).



6.0 EMPLOYEE WORK PERMIT HOLDERS BY TRAINING

Among the employee work permit holders, 39.8 percent (1,799) had No Training or have not stated if they have any training, 24.7 percent (1,115) were Degree holders, 18.7 percent (844) had Certificates and 16.9 percent (765) were Diploma graduates (see Table 1.5a and 1.5b). Table 1.6a and 1.6b shows the work permit holders by the subject of training. Engineering & Allied programs and Craft programs dominated the work permit holders who have stated that they have training, accounting for 18.2 percent and 16.0 percent respectively, followed by work permit holders who have done Commercial, Clerical and Business & Public Administration programs at 13.3 percent.
