



## 1.0 Introduction

This stats brief presents a summary of the characteristics of expatriates who held valid work permits as at end of December 2015.

The Department of Labour and Social Security issue work-permits and copies of approved work-permit applications are forwarded to Statistics Botswana to be analyzed. Although all work permit forms received by Statistics Botswana for a specific quarter are processed and entered into the data base, those valid on the reference dates may still arrive after the publication of the stats brief.

Information on work permit holders gives an indication of whether localization is being achieved or not. It is also of interest to know whether the number of work permit holders is decreasing or not over time. Presentation of work permit holders by occupation and industry gives an indication of jobs currently held by non-citizens or the need for expatriate recruitment. This provides useful information for researchers, planners and policy makers in the country.

Three graphical presentations are given; Figure 1 presents work permit holders by Nationality, with Figures 2 & 3 depicting work permit holders by industry and occupation respectively. More detailed information is presented in tables.


## 2.0 TOTAL WORK PERMIT HOLDERS

The total number of work permit holders that were valid as of end of December 2015 was 6,132. Of these 4,699 (76.6 percent) were employees while 1,433 (23.4 percent) were self – employed. Overall, male work permit holders dominated their female counterparts, 77.5 % and 22.5 % respectively, (See Table 1.1a)

Employee work permit holders consist of those holding new work permits and those whose work permits have been renewed. Table 1.4a shows that 4,039 were the new work permits, while 660 were the renewed ones. For both new and renewed work permits categories, males dominated females. In the new work permit holders category, males accounted for 67.8 percent of total employee work permit holders compared to 18.2 percent for females, while for the renewed, male employee work permit holders accounted for 11.2 percent of the total employee work permit holders compared with 2.8 percent for females.

Table 1.7 shows quarterly work permit holders by industry and sex, from the fourth quarter of 2014 to the last quarter of 2015. Looking at September 2015 and December 2015, total work permits holders increased by 133 persons, from 5,999 in September 2015 to 6,132 in December 2015, an increase of 2.2 percent.

Figure 1 and Table 1.1b shows work permit holders by country of origin. The majority of work permit holders were from Zimbabwe at 2,520 persons (41.1 percent), followed by South Africa with 994 persons (16.2 percent,) and Indian Sub- Continent with 669 persons (10.9 percent).



#### 3.0 WORK PERMIT HOLDRES BY AGE GROUP


Table 1.2a and 1.2b show total work permit holders by type of permit, sex and age distribution. Overall, majority of work permit holders were in age group 35 - 39 (18.7 percent), followed by those aged 30 - 34 (17.9 percent) and 40 - 44 with 17.5 percent. For the self-employed category, age group 40 - 44 had the largest share with 243 persons (17.0 percent), followed by the 45 - 49 with 15.2 percent and 35 - 39 with 15.9 percent. However, for the employee work permit holders, majority of permit holders were found in age group 35 - 39, 19.8 percent, followed by age group 30 - 34 with 19.2 percent and 40 - 44 with 17.7 percent.

# 4.0 WORK PERMIT HOLDERS BY INDUSTRY

Figure 2 presents Employee and Self-Employed work permit holders by Industry. Overall, Agriculture and Construction dominated other industries with a quarter (25.3%) of all work permit holders in the agriculture sector while 17.3 percent were in the construction area.


Looking at the Self Employed, Wholesale & Retail Trade had the highest number of work permit holders at 36.9 percent, followed by Real Estate with 16.5 percent and Manufacturing with 10.3 percent.

For the Employees category, majority were in Agriculture (30.9 percent), followed by Construction with 19.9 percent. Education is the third largest with 10.1 percent



#### 5.0 WORK PERMIT HOLDERS BY OCCUPATION

Figure 3, Tables 1.4a and 1.4b shows employee work permit holders (new and renewed permits) by their occupation. The largest proportion was found in the elementary occupations with 1,368 persons (29.1 percent), followed by Professionals with 954 persons (20.3 percent) and the Managers/ Administrators with 887 persons (18.9 percent).



### **6.0 EMPLOYEE WORK PERMIT HOLDERS BY TRAINING**

From the total of 4,699 employee work permit holders, 39.8 percent (1,871) did not state whether they had any training, whereas 1,193 (25.4 percent) were reported to be degree holders, with a further 843 (17.9 percent) reported to be certificate holders and 792 (16.9 percent) were diploma graduates (see Table 1.5a and 1.5b).

Table 1.6a and 1.6b shows the work permit holders by the subject of training. Among those who had stated their training, Engineering & allied programs was reported by the highest proportion of work permit holders at 19.3 percent, followed by Craft Programs with 15.9 percent, while Commercial, and Business & Public Administration was reported by 13.1 percent.
